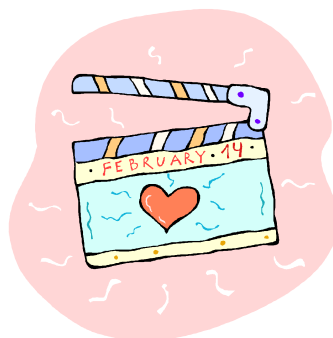

### TUCK SHOPPE

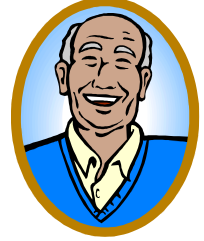
Located near the Reception Desk.

So long lives this and this gives life to thee.

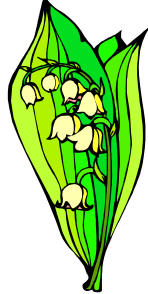

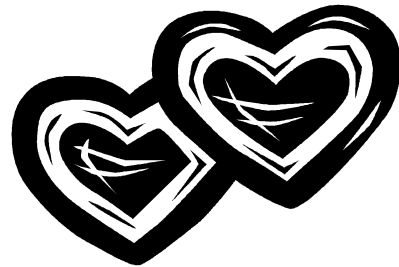
